RESOLUTION

RESOLUTION ADOPTING A POLICY REGULATING USE OF COUNTY-OWNED PARKING LOTS

Introduced by the Administrative Services/Personnel Committee

WHEREAS, the County Board of Commissioners has been granted the authority by the Michigan State Legislature in MCL 46.201, as amended, to maintain and regulate County-owned parking lots, and

WHEREAS, there is a need to adopt and enforce a County parking lot policy to ensure safe and proper use of the parking lots for the general public utilizing County facilities or services.

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Board of Commissioners authorizes the towing of cars parked in such a way as to block access or operation, and further, to tow those individuals not doing business with the County, but only after notification is left on the car.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that before this policy is implemented, signs warning parkers of such policy will be posted and clearly visible in all parking lots subject to this policy.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Purchasing & Properties Department is authorized to enforce said parking regulations, as adopted by the Board of Commissioners.
